




Lifeguard/Instructor Training Program

Eligibility:

- Encouraged to attend the FREE Lifesaving Skills Clinic and information Session
- Reside in Smithers, Telkwa, Witset or Rural Area A
- 15 years old at a minimum
- Willing to meet minimum Casual employee availability for at least 1 year
 - Be available to work within 3, 4-hour blocks of time be open on Saturday or Sundays for a shift. Work a minimum 6 hours/ week.
 - Part-time and Full-time hours available too!
- Complete Bronze Medallion and Bonze Cross Ask about our special rate for those over 15 and who apply for the training program.
- Willing to complete Standard Frist Aid Course
