The Regional District of Bulkley Nechako owns the building and contracts the Society for the operations.

Scope:

The Facility Manager is hired by the Society and is responsible for the effective management and operation of a multi-faceted aquatic and recreation facility. The Manager reports directly to the Society's Board of Directors. This is a full-time salary position that requires some weekend and on-call work. (based on an average of 38 hours/ week)

Responsibilities:

- Hire and maintain a team of employees to ensure effective facility operations
- Oversee all operations. Ensure the facility's physical equipment and systems are maintained and replaced as required.
- Follow, and ensure that facility standards observe Work BC protocols, established industry standard policies and facility safety procedures and standards.
- Ensure the development, delivery and enhancement of recreational programs and opportunities in all areas of the pool and recreation centre.
- Prepare and manage annual and long-term budgets.
- Advise the Board and make recommendations for modifications or improvements to the facility's policies and procedures
- Maintain statistics, prepare program evaluations and reports and make regular presentations
- Act as the primary contact person for interactions with the media, funding organizations and regulatory bodies
- Apply for grant funding

Qualifications:

- Completion of a post-secondary program in Recreation, Business, or a relevant discipline
- 4 years of relevant supervisory experience
- Experience in the creation, implementation, and management of operating and capital budgets
- Experience with promotion and marketing plans
- Demonstration of leadership and human resources management skills
